Commissioner Whiteheart moved for approval of the above-stated Minutes. Commissioner Marshall seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

2. Approval of Releases in Accordance with G.S. 105-381

Commissioner Kaplan moved for approval of the Releases. Commissioner Bailey seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Whiteheart moved for adoption of the above-stated Resolution. Commissioner Kaplan seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.
