**2017 Court Facilities
Capital Projects Ordinance**

Be It Ordained by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners:

Section 1. Revenue.

On December 19, 2016, the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners adopted an order authorizing \$5,000,000 General Obligation Courthouse Bonds for the purpose of providing funds, together with any other available funds, for acquiring, constructing, expanding, improving, renovating, and equipping courthouse buildings and facilities, including without limitation, the acquisition of related land and rights of way in Forsyth County.

Section 2. Authorization for Projects and Appropriation of Funds.

The following amounts are hereby appropriated to the County Manager for approved capital improvement projects for Forsyth County Court facilities. The County Manager is authorized to transfer between appropriation line items, and any such transfer shall be reported to the Board of Commissioners at its next regular meeting and recorded in the minutes of that meeting.
