### SUMMARY OF INFORMATION:

The Personal Health Services Administrative Area of the Forsyth County Department of Public Health has been awarded \$113,750 in additional non-recurring grant funding from the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, Women's and Children's Health Section, Women's Health Branch for evidence-based strategies that reduce the Infant mortality rate in our community. The funding period for these funds is June 1, 2017 through May 31, 2018.

Grant funds will be used to support Nurse-Family Partnership Program staff salaries and fringe benefits, and the purchase of long-acting reversible methods of contraception.
