**ORDINANCE ALLOWING LICENSED RESTAURANTS IN THE UNINCORPORATED
AREAS OF FORSYTH COUNTY TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR ON-
PREMISES CONSUMPTION BEGINNING AT 10:00 A.M. ON SUNDAY MORNING
PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF N.C.G.S. 153A-145.7**

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Legislature enacted N.C.G.S. 153A-145.7 which authorizes a county to adopt an ordinance allowing licensed restaurants to sell alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption beginning at 10:00 a.m. on Sunday morning;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby allows licensed restaurants located in the unincorporated areas of Forsyth County to sell alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption beginning at 10:00 a.m. on Sunday morning pursuant to the restaurant's on-premises malt beverage permit, on-premises unfortified wine permit, on-premises fortified wine permit, or mixed beverages permit.
