On September 12, 2019, the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners adopted a resolution authorizing execution of necessary documents to apply for and receive U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, 2019 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Funds in the amount of \$187,021.

On September 25, 2019, the Sheriff's Office and the County Manager were notified that the grant funds were officially awarded by the Bureau of Justice Assistance. Per the Interlocal Agreement, the grant funds will be shared as follows:

The Grant Projects Ordinance Amendment appropriates the 2019 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Funds, in the amount of \$187,021, into the Justice Assistance Grant Projects Ordinance.

This grant expires on September 30, 2022.
