**COUNTY MANAGER'S RECOMMENDATION OR COMMENTS:** Recommend Approval

**SUMMARY OF INFORMATION:**

The Forsyth County Sheriff's Office has been allocated FY 2016 State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP) grant funds from the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance. This resolution authorizes execution of necessary documents to apply for and receive the grant funds.

According to the Department of Justice Reauthorization Act of 2005 (Pub. L. 109-162, Title XI), SCAAP funds are to be used for correctional purposes only. Jurisdictions receiving SCAAP awards must report the use of funds. In Forsyth County, these funds have typically been used to fund law enforcement equipment and capital expenditures. The Sheriff's Office maintains documents showing past use of funds and projected use of future funds.

No local matching funds are required.
